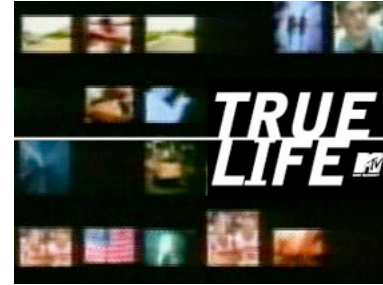


MTV True Life: I'm Homeschooled
